

INDIVIDUAL TAX DOCUMENT CHECKLIST

Employed

o Forms W-2

Unemployed

o Unemployment (1099-G)

Self-Employed

- o Forms 1099-NEC and 1099-K
- o Income records to verify amounts not reported on 1099s.
- o Listing of business expenses totaled by category.
- o Accounting books and records if available (QuickBooks, spreadsheets)
- o Business-use asset information (cost, date placed in service, etc.) for depreciation.
- o Home office information, if applicable
- o SEP / Solo 401K contributions made.

Rental Income

- Records of income and expenses
- o Rental asset information (cost, date placed in service, etc.) for depreciation.
 - HUD-1 or closing statement.

• Retirement Income

- o Pension/IRA/annuity income (1099-R)
- o Traditional IRA basis (prior-year Forms 8606 showing amounts already taxed)
- o Social Security/RRB income (SSA-1099, RRB-1099)

Savings & Investments or Dividends

- o Interest, dividend income (1099-INT, 1099-OID, 1099-DIV)
- o Income from sales of stock or other property (1099-B, 1099-S)
- Dates of acquisition and records of your cost or other basis in property you sold (if basis is not reported on 1099-B)
- o Expenses related to your investments.
- 1099-B and/or 1099-DIV / other documents from cryptocurrencies, NFTs and all other similar type income or loss
- o Cost of all cryptocurrencies, NFTs and other similar type of income sales

Other Income & Losses

- State refunds (Form 1099-G)
- o K-1s either as investment or as active owner
- o Gambling income (W-2G or records showing income, as well as expense records)
- ~ Trusts
- o Royalties (1099-MISC)



- o Any other 1099s received.
- Health Savings Account and long-term care reimbursements (1099-SA or 1099-LTC) Deductions

Home Ownership

- o Form 1098 or other mortgage interest statements
- Real estate and personal property tax records

• Charitable Donations

- Cash amounts donated to religious organizations, schools, other charitable organizations.
- o Records of non-cash charitable donations
- o Amounts of miles driven for charitable purposes

Medical Expenses

- o Amounts paid for healthcare insurance and to doctors, dentists, hospitals.
- o Miles driven for medical purposes.

Health Insurance

o Form 1095-A if you have health insurance through a State Marketplace (Exch)

Childcare Expenses

o Daycare paid for a child under age 13 so the taxpayer (and spouse) can work.

Educational Expenses

- o Forms 1098-T from educational institutions
- o Form 1098-E for student loan interest

Retirement & Other Savings

- o Form 5498-SA showing HSA contributions.
- o Form 5498 showing IRA contributions.
- o All other 5498 series forms (5498-QA, 5498-ESA)

General

- o Record of estimated tax payments made to IRS and / or states.
- o Banking information for direct deposit or direct debit
 - Bank Name, Account #, Routing #, Checking or Savings Account.

Life Events

- o New Spouse Full name, date of birth, SSN
- o New Child Full name as written on Social Security Card, date of birth, SSN.
- o Widow Date of death.
- New mailing address
- Sale of Home or Rental Property
